Section II: Required Health & Safety Measures

1. **COVID-19 Mitigation**. I have read the current guidance issued by both the Center for Disease Control & Prevention ([CDC](#)) and the Arizona Department of Health Services ([ADHS](#)) for mitigating the spread of COVID-19. I am also aware of the State of Arizona [Governor's](#) executive orders regarding event requirements. I agree to implement and enforce safety precautions and restrictions during my event consistent with the guidance and executive orders, including meeting the requirements set forth in this Mitigation Plan. Mcf (initial)
2. **Mask Mandate**. I have read the City of Mesa [Mask Mandate](#). I understand and will ensure that all attendees are always wearing a mask or face shield within the event area, except for (a) children under two years of age, (b) persons with a medical reason preventing them from wearing a mask or face shield, (c) attendees who are actively eating or drinking, (d) athletes and sporting officials while actively officiating or participating in an athletic event or on the field of play. Mcf (initial)
3. **Six-Foot Distance**. I will ensure that all attendees who are not members of the same household or sporting team maintain a six (6) foot social distance, except while actively officiating or participating in a sporting event or on the field of play. Mcf (initial)

4. Exposure/Symptoms. I will notify attendees that they are prohibited from entering the event area if they feel unwell; in the last 14 days, have tested positive for COVID-19 or been in close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19; or if they are experiencing the symptoms of fever, cough, or shortness of breath that could be attributable to COVID-19. I understand that it is a violation of the Mitigation Plan if I am aware of an attendee who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to the event and I do not prohibit that person's attendance. Mcf (initial)
5. Signs Required. Although the City of Mesa provides some signage at its facilities, I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that adequate signage is posted at the event notifying attendees of the requirements above related to masks, maintaining a six-foot social distance, and the prohibition of attendees with exposure to or symptoms of COVID-19. Mcf (initial)
6. Handwashing & Hand Sanitizing. I will ensure that adequate handwashing sinks or hand sanitizing stations will be made available and placed throughout the event area for attendees use. Mcf (initial)
7. Athletic Field Attendee Capacity. I understand that even if the total number of attendees at my event will exceed 50 persons, each athletic field at the event can have no more than a total of 50 persons at the field as a spectator or participant (e.g. athletes, officiants, and coaches). Mcf (initial only if event will be held at an athletic field)
8. Swimming Pool Facility Capacity. I understand that my event must comply with the attendee capacity requirements for the specific aquatics site that my event will occur at as determined by the City's Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department that will be provided to me. _____ (initial only if event will be held at aquatics facility)
9. Responsible Parties for Enforcement. It is the responsibility of event organizer(s) to have designated staff members, volunteers, or security who will actively monitor the event area to enforce the health and safety measures in this Mitigation Plan. I am required to fill out the responsible parties form listing all person(s) and who will be the responsible parties at the event for monitoring and enforcing the Mitigation Plan. Responsible parties should ensure the Mitigation Plan is enforced including, if necessary, requiring attendees to leave the event who refuse to comply or halting play until compliance is achieved. Mcf (initial)

Section III: Event Specific Health Protocols

To ensure my event remains in compliance with [Arizona Executive Order 2020-59](#), and the CDC and ADHS guidelines relating to safety precautions for mitigating the spread of COVID-19, in addition to the required health and safety measures listed in Section II, I will enact and enforce the following additional protocols (by way of example, additional signage, spacing requirements, sanitization methods, etc.). Section IV: Event Cancellation – Dispersion Requirements

I understand that the failure to meet the event requirements above can result, without prior notice, in the revocation of the event permit and the immediate cancellation of my event by the City of Mesa without the refunding of any fees. Should the City of Mesa cancel my event while the event is in progress, I understand it will be my responsibility to ensure that the attendees are notified and dispersed in an orderly and safe manner.

I hereby certify that all answers and information provided on this form are true and correct. Any false, misleading, or incomplete information constitutes grounds for the denial or revocation of my sporting event permit. I understand that, if the event registration is approved, the safety precautions in this Mitigation Plan must be implemented and enforced and that the failure to do so can result in the City of Mesa’s revocation, without refund, of the event permit in whole or in part (e.g. cancel the entire event or certain event activities), the denial of future event permits or registrations for myself and/or the organization I represent, and that I may be liable for a Class 1 misdemeanor (A.R.S. § 26-317).
